NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Zoning Board of Appeals of the Village of Tinley Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois, will conduct a Public Hearing #Z-03-11 beginning at the hour of 7:30 P.M., on Thursday, **APRIL 14, 2011** at the Village Hall in the Council Chamber, 16250 S. Oak Park Avenue, Tinley Park, Illinois, to consider recommending that the Village Board grant a 2-foot variance from Section III, Schedule 2 of the Tinley Park Zoning Ordinance, to allow for a 23-foot setback where 25-foot setback is required for a 6-foot high fence on the Normandy Drive (east) frontage of this corner lot at 6507 W. 167th Street in the R-4, Single Family Residential Zoning District and within the Parkside Subdivision.

LOT 2 IN BLOCK 4 IN THE RESUBDIVISION OF PART OF THE PARKSIDE, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (EXCEPT THE SOUTH 330 FEET OF THE WEST 330 FEET THEREOF) OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 36 NORTH, RANGE 13 EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS. (**COMMONLY KNOWN AS: 6507 W. 167TH STREET, TINLEY PARK, ILLINOIS; JEREMY MIKRUT – PETITIONER**)
