1. Senior Community Center Administrative Report

A. Finance Report

B. Senior Community Center Operations

1. Membership

Membership is slow but still ongoing. Can register by phone, mail or in person. No official numbers due to Linda Sullivan's absence. Lots of mail was returned and the membership list needs to be updated.

2. Programs & Special Events

Bob Hayes had a clean-up day at the Senior Center. Bulletin boards were updated, computers updated and are running with current/updated software, new card shuffler was provided to the Senior Center with the ability to shuffle six decks of cards.
