OLD AND UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Studio

Mike Sevier talked about a camera that is only \$1500 so not very expensive. It's made by Black Magic. It's very compact and operated by a switcher to do the focus

Donna Framke stated there are apps out there that can use live streaming. The existing website is about 7 years old so the platform does not support what we want to do at this point. We can put a link on the website and accessing/streaming through the website. Hopefully in the next 1-2 weeks the preliminary research will be completed.

Reta Brudd stated that the meetings are broken down into 30 minute intervals for uploading purposes. She also stated that if you buy the cameras for the village hall and mount them it doesn't help if you can't use them somewhere else.

Joe De Nova stated he has uploaded as much as two hours on You Tube.

Scholarships

Reta Brudd reported that all scholarships were presented, nice presentation. Microphone was a little bit high, the microphone does not swivel. These kids were incredible. The one that touched her the most was the one who worked at the mission trip and then ended up logging over 500 volunteer hours.

Al Siegers asked if anyone has a log of the past winners. Maybe they could be contacted to see what they are doing now.

Reta Brudd suggested a follow-up TV show/project. She also stated that **Don Budny** would need some help with that project but maybe we can use some of the newly appointed members. She thinks the follow-up for scholarship winners is a great idea.

Donna Framke thinks the show would remind people that the program is still out there and still available.

Reta Brudd stated the program began in 2000 so it has been going on for 16 years.

New Business

Reta Brudd stated that CRC is taking a two month summer break and we have been doing the same projects which are all important and wonderful projects but we have this dead time from the end of April to basically November. This is the time to consider new projects, surveys, etc. and we should jot some ideas down over the summer as to what new projects we can do in the future. One huge project is Discover Tinley, but most of the work falls on **Al Siegers and Denise Politano** even though we all help with stuffing the envelopes and helping the day before and the day of Discovery Tinley. We also help with the Christmas Market but we need to try to come up with some new ideas. What can we change? Where do we want to see change? Also, the scholarship judges want to meet with us to revamp the applications. Some students are not putting hours down and without the hours listed it is hard to judge applications. Reta thinks we

need to take the position that if the students do not put hours down then we are not judging their applications. We also need someone good on publisher or something similar to put the app back together again.

Donna Framke inquired about any changes being made to Youth in Government.

Reta Brudd talked with Trustee Younker and asked him to feel out people about Youth in Government. Trustee Younker didn't think it would make much difference to change the time of the year from fall to January or February. **Ron Centanni** will be checking with the schools to see what conflicts might exist. Reta thinks this might be more advantageous for the schools. The dates won't be changed for this coming year but maybe for the years after.
