Lane Bryant Homicides Reward Increase

Due to generous donations from sources wishing to remain anonymous, the reward in the Lane Bryant homicides has been increased to \$100,000. This amount will be paid to the person who provides information leading to the arrest and charging of the murderer in this crime. The reward is not dependant upon conviction.

The law enforcement personnel working this case continue to follow up on tips and leads as they develop on a daily basis. Currently, there have been over 2300 tips that have been investigated. The public is urged to call the tip hotline (708-444-5394) with any information that may assist in the apprehension of the killer, regardless of how insignificant they may think the information may be.

At 6:00 this evening there will be a prayer vigil in the Lane Bryant parking lot (Brookside Market Plaza, 191st Street and Harlem Ave., Tinley Park). The vigil is sponsored by faith leaders from the surrounding area. The public is invited to attend.
